Thank you to all those that completed the survey I shared last week.

There are some really positive results to share with you:

- 98% say their child is happy at Windmill
- 100% say their child is safe, and that any reports of bullying are dealt with, with effective communication to parents
- 100% say they would recommend Windmill to other parents/carers

There are some things I think we can better at too:

- 1 person said they didn't feel that we dealt well with a concern they raised
- 6 people said they don't know what their child is learning about
- 2 people think that we don't believe in their child and have high expectations for them
