



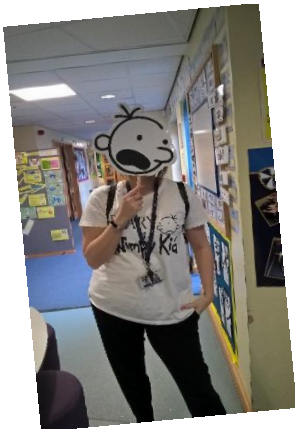

Parent Pay

Parent Pay is now live! We are urging parents to activate their accounts as soon as possible. If you need any help with activating your account, please ask us at the office. This will enable you to pay online for clubs and trips. This is NOT for school dinners (yet); dinners will still need to be done through the Telford and Wrekin website or via the class teacher.

Absence

Could we please ask families to phone in your child's absence by 9:30am letting us know your child's name, class and reason for absence. A call is then required for EACH day of absence thereafter. Failure to adhere to this could result in an 'Unauthorised absence' being recorded on the school register which will affect your child's and the Class attendance figure.
