Your child did not have the correct school uniform today. We would like you to be aware of the ticked boxes below, indicating the correct uniform as agreed by governors as school policy.

- Shoes: plain black, waterproof, with heels no more than 2cm, no boots above ankle-height
- Socks: plain black/navy/grey/white socks (or tights)
- Trousers/skirt/shorts: plain black
- Dress: navy check or yellow check
- Polo shirt: white or royal blue (gold for Year 6 only) – plain white shirt may also be worn
- Sweatshirt/cardigan: navy

- PE kit: white or navy t-shirt, navy shorts (navy tracksuit/sweatshirt can be worn outdoors)

- Swimming: trunks or swimming shorts (not long) for boys, costume (not bikini) for girls

- Clothing must be plain or with the old/new school logo. No other logos/colours are allowed.
- No jewellery, apart from a simple watch and single stud earrings, is allowed.
- Make-up, nail varnish and other body decoration is not allowed.
- Hair should be natural: we prefer children not to have shaved hair designs or hair dye.

If there is a specific reason why your child did not have the correct uniform today, please let us know as soon as possible. If there is a reason why your child will not have the correct uniform in the future, please write to us to explain.

'It's in the wash' is not considered an acceptable reason for children not having correct uniform.

I would also like to remind and recommend that all clothing be marked with the child's name.
